He is the founder of All of Us & You Youth Center, a non-profit organization that reaches out to youth throughout the community of the south-side of Chicago, IL. He continues to travel extensively to share his testimony with others on how God delivered him from what was a deep nightmare he was trapped in for so many years.*

*Being born and raised in a church going family, Mr. Phillips still experienced obstacles in his life. By God's grace he was able to overcome a street mentality from gang banging, hustlin', being angry and mentally anguish. He was expelled from one grammar school because of behavior problems at the age of 12. He then began to live a fast and dangerous life; he was exposed to the lifestyles of gangs, thugs, drug dealers, and drug addicts. Once Antonio realized that the lifestyle he was living would cause him to be either in the penitentiary or dead, he searched for a way out.*

*From 1989 to 1991, the staff at the YMCA in Chicago encouraged Antonio to turn his life around. In 1994 the transformation began, he was able to begin his newfound life when he surrendered and turned his life over to God. Antonio joined Pioneer Missionary Baptist Church; at that time he was searching for something more powerful than he thought imaginable. He was out there in the streets for so many years somehow one day the Holy Spirit came and grabbed a hold of him. From that day forward God continues to be the center of his life. Then the process of his life began to make a complete change, he got involved with youth ministry that met every Wednesday and Saturday at Pioneer Missionary Baptist Church. Antonio graduated high school with a 3.7 G.P.A, for this he received the "National Honor Society Achievement Award". In 1996, Antonio enrolled at Florida A&M College; He successfully earned his Bachelor's of Science Degree in Electrical Engineering from an Online University. Antonio's message of deliverance and hope far exceeds the desperation accompanied by the oppression of many silent sufferers.*

*In 1999, Antonio married his high school sweetheart and is now fathering three beautiful healthy honor roll children, with one on the way. He is truly a servant of God, and an inspiration too many who've found themselves at the brink of despair. Antonio's message is pure and simple: Reach the heart and save the soul.*

*God has the answer and is the answer to fulfill your every need. In Him all things are possible if you don't die during your valley experience. His model is, "Be the Change you want to see in yourself". As of April 2000, Antonio relocated his family to the south suburbs of Chicago and joined Holy Ghost Deliverance Center (A.K.A. River of Life Worship Center), where he remains today as one of their Youth Leaders.*
